Status Tagging Systems

What can be customised?

Firstly, you need to decide on the **size of holder and/or insert** required. Scafftag offers a range of standard holders and inserts to suit different sized equipment and attachment requirements (see our Tagging Systems Technical Specification Sheet). Inserts can be sized to your requirements, subject to a cutter set up charge.

Both our **holders and / or inserts** can be custom designed.

Holders can be **overprinted with your logo** or required text in **single or four colours**.



With **inserts** you can select:

- ✓ **Data** to be recorded/displayed
- ✓ **Background colour(s)**
- ✓ Logo inclusion
- ✓ Font style

Both sides of the insert can be customised. The only restriction you face is the print area available.

Both holders and inserts can be:

- ✓ **Sequentially numbered** for unique asset identification and status management
- ✓ Fitted with metal strips for **magnetic detection** e.g. food preparation plants
- ✓ Chipped to work in conjunction with **Safetrak® electronic management tool**

How much does it cost?

Scafftag **does not charge a consultancy fee** for developing the **design brief** for your customised status tagging system.

You only pay when you are happy with the design brief. Once satisfied, you pay an artwork charge of £50 per face. Holders are classed as one face only. Providing no amendments need to be made, the artwork charge is a one off fee.

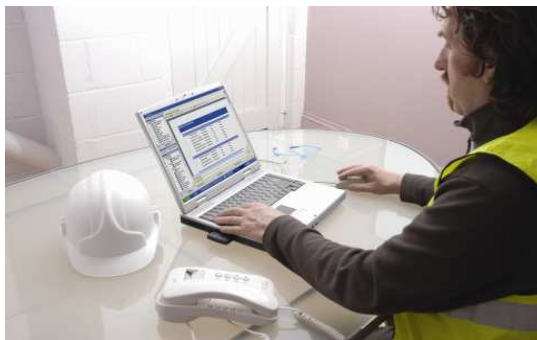
Then each time you order, you pay a customised holder/insert price (quoted based on design and number of colours) plus a print run charge for printing your customised designs. The print run charge is dependent on volume – the higher the print run volume, the lower the cost per holder/insert.

Delivery charges are the same as standard Scafftag products (see price list).

What can be customised?

All 3 elements of the Safetrak® system **can be customised** to your requirements:

- ✓ Electronically chipped Scafftag status tagging systems

As well as customising the tagging systems as described above, a choice of different **electronic chips** are available to suit different environments. These vary by technology (Radio Frequency Identification / barcode / serial number), size, ruggedness and attachment to the tagging system.

A wide range of **handheld computers / devices** are also available to suit different industrial environments including **rugged** and **intrinsically safe models**.

Both the central planning and individual inspection modules (e.g. ladders, PAT testing) that make up the **Safetrak® software** can be adapted to account for your specific:

- ✓ Inspection checklists
- ✓ Frequency of tasks and work schedules
- ✓ Reporting requirements

Individual inspection modules are already available for the most common equipment and issues. These can be adapted to your requirements. Or, if you have a unique issue or rarer item of equipment not currently covered by the Safetrak® range, a brand new module can be developed.

Scafftag can also deliver customised training and ongoing support packages to ensure your solution is effectively implemented.

How much does it cost?

As with customising our tagging systems, Scafftag do not charge a consultancy fee for developing your Safetrak® requirements brief – unless an IT specialist is required to visit onsite. The requirements brief will consider all of the customisable elements above.

Once your requirements brief has been developed, Scafftag will provide you with a proposal for the tagging systems, hardware, software licences, software development time and any training and ongoing support required and the total cost of the project.
